

ORDINANCE NO. 207**AN ORDINANCE TO ISSUE EMERGENCY RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PROMOTION OF HEALTH, CLEANLINESS, COMFORT AND SAFETY OF DELAWARE TOWNSHIP**

Now, therefore, be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

I. Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to allow the Board of Supervisors to issue emergency regulations, including but not limited to those pertaining to building moratoriums, water conservation, outdoor burning, curfews, distributions of necessitates, etc., to promote the health, cleanliness, comfort and safety of Township property, residents and others during emergency conditions.

II. Definitions as used in this Ordinance.

The following terms shall have the meanings as indicated:

"Health and safety emergency" - An unusual occurrence or situation which is expected to be temporary, in the sole discretion of the Delaware Township Board of Supervisors, has caused, causes, or will cause a deleterious effect upon the health, cleanliness, comfort, or safety of Township property, residents, or others.

All other definitions of words in this Ordinance are listed alphabetically in the definitions dictionary located at the beginning of the combined Ordinances of Delaware Township, and are adopted herein by reference.

III. Emergency Powers.

When, in the sole discretion of the Delaware Township Board of Supervisors, a health and safety emergency exists, the Board of Supervisors may, by motion or resolution, take any lawful means necessary to abate the emergency or lessen its deleterious effects, including but not limited to the issuance of building moratoriums, water conservation measures, outdoor burning bans, curfews, distribution of necessities, and any and all other lawful means necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance. Whenever such action is taken, it shall remain in effect until such time as the Board of Supervisors, in its sole


discretion, believe that such measures are no longer appropriate under these circumstances, at which time such actions shall be lifted by resolution or motion of the Board of Supervisors.

IV. Penalties.

Any person found to be in violation of any regulation issued pursuant to this Ordinance, or who resists or interferes with any officers, agents, or employees of the the Township who, in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, are in the performance of their duty, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in an amount up to \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollars) per violation, and/or incarceration in the Pike County Jail for not more than 30 (thirty) days.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
