RESOLUTION 2018-02
CREATION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FUND

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. 66553;

The Township of Delaware, Pike County, Pennsylvania is hereby creating an EMERGENCY SERVICES FUND. This Fund is being established for anticipated capital expenses for the purpose of ensuring that fire and emergency medical services are provided within the township by the means and to the extent determined by the township, including the appropriate financial and administrative assistance for these services. The board of supervisors may appropriate moneys from the township general funds to be paid into the Emergency Services Fund or place in the fund any moneys received from the sale, lease or other disposition of any township property or from any other source. These Emergency Services Fund moneys shall be invested, reinvested and administered in a manner consistent with the provisions of section 3204 relating to the investment of township funds generally.
