



RESOLUTION NO. 2018-06

The Delaware Township Board of Supervisors has resolved the following policy regarding use of bulk waste facilities in Delaware Township:

Volunteers from the following groups will be permitted to have access to the Delaware Township dump for a total of four (4) times during any one (1) calendar year at no cost.

- Delaware Township Volunteer Fire Company
- Delaware Township Volunteer Ambulance Corps.

A list of volunteers must be provided and updated accordingly as membership changes by these two groups. Those considered to be volunteers are those who actively respond to calls. Free disposal cannot be transferred to a friend or family member. It is to be used for the volunteer only. If more than one volunteer resides in the same household, only four (4) free bulk disposals will be provided.


Should free bulk disposal be used when a volunteer is no longer active in the above organizations, the Township will bill you for the service.


Any violation or abuse of this privilege will result in revocation of any privileges associated herein and you will be billed for the service.


This resolution will supersede Resolution No. 2012-07.
